CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN V. and LETHA E. COLLIER

of P. O. Box 455, Eagle Point, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Little Butte Creek

a tributary of _____ for the purpose of
irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 498; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1883

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per
second from April 1st to October 1st of each year.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Diver-
sion point located: 290 feet North and 1025 feet East from the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 36.
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

2.4 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 36
T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion and place
of use approved by an order of the State Engineer entered March 18, 1968, and
recorded in State Engineer's Special Order Record, Volume 16, page 509.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
