CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That VENSON A. HUNT

of Route 1, Box 130, Rogue River, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 34.0 acres

under Permit No. E-191 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 27, 1913

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.423 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW¼ SE¼, Section 20, T. 34 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 560 feet North and 565 feet East from S¼ Corner, Section 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.0 acres NW¼ SE¼
25.0 acres SW¼ SE¼
Section 20
T. 34 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to J. N. Hockersmith and recorded at page 1997, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 45.0 acres. A change in the right to the use of water appurtenant to 11.0 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered November 20, 1970. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by order of the State Engineer entered April 16, 1959 and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to J. N. Hockersmith.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
