## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** JAMES W. PAYNE

of Cave Junction, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of Sucker Creek

a tributary of East Fork Illinois River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 7.6 acres  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1, at page 253; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1858

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.152 cubic foot per  
second, and that the use of water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to  
the season April 1st to October 31st of each year.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 29, T. 39 S., R. 7 W., W. M. Div-  
ersion point located: 1600 feet North and 1650 feet West from SE Corner, Section 29.  
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

6.5 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
1.1 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 25  
T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to A. N. McVey and recorded at page 7146, Volume  
7, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of  
water for irrigation of 50.0 acres. A change in the right to the use of water  
appurtenant to 42.4 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered  
September 30, 1970. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to  
the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued  
to A. N. McVey.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
