CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That THOMAS HART, STUART RUDA and RILEY FURLONG

of 5808 Redwood Avenue, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 72.0 acres and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from October, 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.44 cubic feet per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, T. 36 S., R. 6 W., W.M. Diversion point located 1020 feet South and 2570 feet West from NE Corner, Section 31. A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered August 3, 1967, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to J. L. Helms and recorded at page 32900, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
