CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ERNEST J. WALSH, M.D.

of 1112 Richmon Knoll, Fullerton, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Louse Creek

a tributary of Jump-Off-Joe Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 14.0 acres

under Permit No. 4512 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 26, 1920

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.175 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, T. 35 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 820 feet South and 610 feet West from the NE Corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

14.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 30
T. 35 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Ernest J. Walsh, M.D. and recorded at page 33569, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 24.0 acres. A change in the right to the use of water appurtenant to 10.0 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered November 20, 1970. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Ernest J. Walsh, M.D.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
