CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. A. HOGUE

of Selma, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream

a tributary of Deer Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 14.8 acres

under Permit No. 7759 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 2, 1927

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.185 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T. 38 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.8 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
11.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 11
T. 38 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to W. A. Hogue and recorded at page 8632, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 16.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 1.2 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered December 14, 1970. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to W. A. Hogue.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
