## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE V. and MARION E. HUMPHREYS

of 5044 Gayhurst, Baldwin Park , State of California , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 4.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 16843 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 12, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.058 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE% SW%, as projected within Chapman DLC 43, Section 8, T. 30 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 120 feet South and 900 feet West from NE Corner, Chapman DLC 43.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right cristing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.3 acres SE4 SW4
2.3 acres NE4 SW4
both as projected within Andrew Chapman DLC 43
Section 8
T. 30 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to T. W. Allen and recorded at page 16806, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 10.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 5.4 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered March 4, 1969. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered June 30, 1964 and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to T. W. Allen.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
