**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify,** That **CECIL and IMOGENE BATMAN and DALE FRIDAY and SHIRLEY FRIDAY** of **Oregon**, State of **California**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the **STATE ENGINEER** of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **two natural water courses**

a tributary of **Goose Lake** for the purpose of **irrigation of 32.2 acres**

under Permit No. **31965** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **June 20, 1966**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.81 cubic foot per second, being 0.15 c.f.s. from south water course and 0.66 c.f.s. from north water course**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NW¼ NW¼, SE¼ NW¼, Section 19, T. 40 S., R. 19 E., W. M.** Diversion points located: **1320 feet West and 620 feet North; 850 feet due South; both from SE Corner, NW¼ NW¼, Section 19.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
