CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN SITTON by CHARLES E. SITTON, JR.

of Route 1, Box 162, Carlton, State of Oregon has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed drainageway and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-40272, Permit No. R-4480 and North Yamhill River a tributary of North Yamhill River for the purpose of wildfowl habitat

under Permit No. 29958 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 15, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4), Section 29; NW 1/4 NW 1/4, as projected within Ramage DLC 65, Section 33, T. 3 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion points located: 870 feet South and 1240 feet West; 1070 feet South and 20 feet*

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 3 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4)
Section 29
T. 3 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Water to be diverted from the unnamed drainageway when available and any deficiency is to be made up by diversion from the North Yamhill River, providing that the total quantity diverted from both streams shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The right allowed herein shall be subordinate and inferior to all future rights except for like purposes.

*East, both from NE Corner, Lot 1 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), Section 28.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
