CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That H. B. SANDER and L. B. SANDER

of Ashland, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Ashland Creek

a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 57.1 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1864;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.721 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, T. 39 S., R. 1 E., W. M.
Diversion point located below:
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

28.4 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 4

26.7 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 5
T. 39 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

2.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 32
T. 38 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

Diversion point located: (Smith-Myer, Roper ditch) 850 feet North and 300 feet
West from SW Corner, Million DLC 41.

Certificate of water right issued to H. B. Sander and L. B. Sander and recorded
at page 16031, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the
right to the use of water for irrigation of 61.0 acres. Subsequently, the point
of diversion, place of use and character of use for the irrigation of 3.9 acres
was changed by order of the State Engineer entered September 30, 1970. This
certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for
irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to H. B. Sander and
L. B. Sander.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
