CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. L. and ETHEL BUSH

of Route 1, Box 67-0, Rogue River, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
irrigation of 6.2 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from March 1, 1907;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W.M. Diver-
sion point located: 1080 feet North and 315 feet West from SE Corner, Section 10.
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

6.2 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 10
T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by
an order of the State Engineer entered November 10, 1969, and together with the
certificate recorded at page 36605, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certifi-
cates, supersedes the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Ed Thompson
and C. W. Wilcox and recorded at page 16116, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right
Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
