## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That D. A. and PAUL B. MORTON

of Box 83, Siletz , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Spring and Unnamed Creek

a tributary of Siletz River irrigation of 2.1 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 11391 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 22, 1934

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second;

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 8 (W/2 NW/4 NW/4), Section 3, T. 10 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shali

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is

appurtenant, is as follows:

2.1 acres Lot 8 (W/2 NW/4 NW/4)
Section 3
T. 10 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to D. A. and Paul B. Morton and recorded at page 14364, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 15.2 acres. A change in the right to the use of water appurtenant to 13.1 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered February 23, 1971. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to D. A. and Paul B. Morton.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
