## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** J. W. McDONOUGH

of Ashland, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of Neil Creek

a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of  
irrigation of 7.8 acres and domestic use  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1854;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.095 cubic foot per  
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 19, T. 39 S., R. 2 E., W.M. Diver-  
sion point located: 330 feet South and 65 feet West from SW Corner, DLC 43.  
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

7.8 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 19  
T. 39 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to J. W. McDonough and recorded at page 36141,  
Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the  
use of water for irrigation of 18.8 acres. A change in the right to the use of  
water appurtenant to 11.0 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered  
March 2, 1971. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the  
use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to  
J. W. McDonough.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
