that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second.

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The point of diversion is located in the SEM NEW, Section 21, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W.M. Diversion point located: 1420 feet South and 310 feet West from NE Corner, Section 21. A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.8 acres SE% NE% Section 21

8.0 acres SW/4 NW/4 Section 22 T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is more explicitly described as follows: Lot 6, Pleasant Valley Farm Tracts.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by orders of the State Engineer entered July 28, 1969 and September 12, 1969, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Paul S. Seeley and recorded at page 36142, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
