or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NW/ NEM), Section 24, T. 39 S., R. 8 E., W. M. Diversion point located: 615 feet South and 1640 feet West from NE Corner, Section 24.

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
