CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Lawrence J. Bertsch

of 2145 Turnage N.W. Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooya River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of Irrigation of 288.2 acres

under Permit No. 30219 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 27, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.93 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Osborne DLC 53 Section 12, T. 14 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 1580 feet South and 420 feet West from NE Corner, Osborne DLC 53.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

a tributary of Wiley Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 0.5 acre

under Permit No. 30388 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 20, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, T. 13 S., R. 1 E., W. M. Spring located: 420 feet South and 230 feet West from SE Corner, Humphrey DLC 38.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 acre Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
