## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That

ELMER STOLLER

of Route 1, Box 313 D, Independence , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rickreall Creek

a tributary of Willamette River irrigation of 30.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 13915 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 7, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWA SEM, as projected within Burch DIC 47, Section 29, T. 7 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 1110 feet East and 610 feet North from SWA Corner. Section 29.

and 610 feet North from S% Corner, Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2% acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.2 acres SW4 SE4 8.8 acres SE4 SE4 both as projected within Burch DLC 47 Section 29

3.2 acres NEW NEW
8.8 acres NWW NEW
both as projected within Burch DLC 47
Section 32
T. 7 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion and place of use approved by an order of the State Engineer entered May 18, 1967, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to C. Barendrecht and recorded at page 16849, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
