of Fort Klamath , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Fort Creek

a tributary of Wood River irrigation of 74.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 6369 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 14. 1924

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.93 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NE% SW%. Section 23. T. 33 S. R. 7½ E. W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

34.4 acres Lot 8 (SW% SE%) 40.0 acres NW% SE% Section 27 T. 33 S., R. 7½ E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to supersede the certificate issued to D. W. Ryan and recorded at page 6700, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates, so as to correctly show the amount of water to which such right is entitled.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
