CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES W. CLACK

of N. Myrtle Rte., Box 204, Myrtle Creek, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Myrtle Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 19.1 acres

under Permit No. 3541 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 24, 1917

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Browning DLC 41, Sec. 18, T. 29 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.2 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Browning DLC 41
Section 17

14.7 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Browning DLC 41
4.2 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Browning DLC 41
Section 18

T. 29 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Diversion points located: 780 feet South and 30 feet West; 1290 feet South and 790 feet West; both from NE Corner, Section 18.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered March 10, 1961, and together with the certificates recorded at pages 37651, 37657, and 37658, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate of water right issued to T. R. Dunnavin and recorded at page 3498, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
