**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**      **CONSTANCE M. NEALE**

of **Box 27, Agoura**, State of **California**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **North Myrtle Creek**

a tributary of **South Umpqua River** for the purpose of irrigation of **5.2 acres**

under Permit No. **3541** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **August 24, 1917**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.065 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 7, T. 29 S., R. 4 W., W. M.** Diversion point located: **580 ft. N. & 50 ft. W. from NE Corner, Sec. 18.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**5.2 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 7  
T. 29 S., R. 4 W., W. M.**

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered June 2, 1954, and together with the certificates recorded at pages 37651, 37656, and 37657, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to T. R. Dunnavin, and recorded at page 3498, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
