This Is to Certify, That J. W. NEATHAMER

of Rogue River , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River irrigation of 4.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 6124 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 1. 1923

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEM SWM, Section 34, T. 34 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 530 feet South and 790 feet West from the SM Corner, Section 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.0 acres NW/4 NE/4 Section 4 T. 35 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to J. W. Neathamer and recorded at page 7484, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 11.0 acres. A change in the right to the use of water appurtenant to 7.0 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered August 10, 1971. The certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to J. W. Neathamer.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is rr . cted to the lands or place of use herein described.
