CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 62

of 1417 12th Street, Oregon City, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Newell Creek (Abernathy Creek) for the purpose of irrigation of 9.4 acres and air conditioning and heating

under Permit No. G-3013 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 8, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.48 cubic foot per second, being 0.12 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.36 cubic foot per second for air conditioning and heating,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ as projected within Fisher DLC 44, Section 33, T. 2 S., R. 2 E., W. M. Well located: 1820 feet North and 2670 feet East from SW Corner, Fisher DLC 44.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2¹/₂ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Air Conditioning and Heating and 8.9 acres NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄
Air Conditioning and Heating and 0.5 acre SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄
Both as projected within Fisher DLC 44
Section 33
T. 2 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
