CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **JENS JORGENSEN**

of **Route 1, Box 400, Coquille**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Lampa Creek**

a tributary of **Coquille River** for the purpose of **irrigation of 27.8 acres**

under Permit No. **25803** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **September 30, 1958**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.19 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Lot 6 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Lot 11 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 5, T. 29 S., R. 13 W., W. M.** Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.6 acres Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
10.0 acres Lot 6 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
11.1 acres Lot 11 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
0.1 acre Lot 12 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 5
T. 29 S., R. 13 W., W. M.

Diversion points located: 1080 feet North and 1100 feet East; 650 feet North and 1420 feet East; 170 feet North and 1740 feet East; 250 feet South and 2000 feet East; 640 feet South and 1940 feet East; all from W $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 5.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
