that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second being 0.005 cubic foot per second from each of springs 1, 2, 3

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEY NAM, SEM NAMA, Section 24, T. 29 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Springs located below

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ______of one cubic foot per second per acre,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
