or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEM SEM, Section 35, T. 28 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 169 feet North and 1005 feet West from SE Corner, Section 35

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ______of one cubic foot per second per acre,
