CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LYLE WOODCOCK

of 11655 Williams Highway, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Waste collected in Woodcock Trench, Woodcock reservoir constructed under Application No. R-38699, Permit No. R-3862 a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 7.2 acres and supplemental irrigation of 9.4 acres

under Permit No. 29162 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 9, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second from waste water in Trench, and 7.7 acre feet stored water only from reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35 T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-3862; and shall be further limited to a total diversion from the reservoir of not to exceed 7.7 acre feet per year. And shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water;*

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.2 acre	3.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
1.0 acre	3.2 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
5.6 acres	3.2 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.4 acre	SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

* Provided further that the right to use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth.

Diversion points located: Trench - 2420 feet North and 1600 feet West; Reservoir - 170 feet North and 1080 feet West; all from S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 35, T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
