under Permit No. G-2748 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 24, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.11 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE% NW%, as projected within Pullen DLC 44, Section 29, T. 1 N., R. 3 E., W. M. Well located: 1150 feet North and 1800 feet West from SE Corner, George B. Pullen DLC 44.

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This right is subject to the provision that use of water for air conditioning and cooling in excess of 5000 gallons per day shall be subsequent in priority to future beneficial consumptive use unless a two well system is constructed and all the water wasted from the system recharged to the same ground water reservoir from which it was withdrawn.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
