CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That REYNOLDS METALS CO.

of Sundial Road, Troutdale, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Well No. 17

a tributary of Sandy River for the purpose of Industrial (aluminum reduction)

under Permit No. G-4510 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 2, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.3 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 23, T. 1 N., R. 3 E., W. M. Well located: 580 feet North and 1350 feet West from SW Corner, Calvin Reed DLC 60

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
