under Permit No. 10203 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 2, 1931

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.45 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEM SEM as projected within Watson DLC 40, Section 30, T. 10 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 1850 feet South and 280 feet East from NW Corner, Watson DLC 40.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
