CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SPAULDING PULP & PAPER COMPANY

of P. O. Box 70, Newberg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of Manufacturing and fire protection

under Permit No. 8106 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 30, 1927

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 8.0 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the E 1/2 NW 1/4, Section 29, T. 3 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 29
T. 3 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to supersede the certificate issued to Spaulding Pulp & Paper Company and recorded at page 7644, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates, so as to correct the priority date.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
