CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That L. M. and MARION SUE INGRAM

of Route 1, Box 124, Haines, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of two waste water drains a tributary of Powder River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 190.0 acres under Permit No. 32604 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 25, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.27 cubic feet per second, being 2.47 cubic feet per second from drain number 1 and 1.80 cubic feet per second from drain number 2,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the West Drain: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; East Drain: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; Section 20, T. 7 S., R. 39 E., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{3}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
