CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE ALFRED TRUMBO

of Kellogg Stor Route, Box 22, Oakland , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooia Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 20.0 acres and stock

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 32627 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 23, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an umount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second, being 0.25 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.01 cubic foot per second for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEM NWM, as projected within Dodge DLC 47, Section 12, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lards, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.3 acres NW/4 NE/4
1.9 acres SW/4 NE/4
7.0 acres NE/4 NW/4
Stock and 8.8 acres SE/4 NW/4
All as projected within Dodge DLC 47
Section 12
T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

Diversion points located: 270 feet North and 790 feet East; 10 feet North and 550 feet East; both from northerly NW Corner, Williamson DLC 48.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
