CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That McCLELLAN O. and DOROTHY B. KNAPP

of Route 2, Box 1060, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Umpqua River and Calapooya Creek a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 230.9 acres under Permit No. 28110 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 8, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.88 cubic feet per second, being 1.63 cubic feet per second from Umpqua River and 1.25 cubic feet per second from Calapooya Creek when available, and any deficiency in the available supply in Calapooya Creek is to be made up by additional diversion from the Umpqua River provided that the total quantity diverted from both streams shall not exceed 2.88 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Watson DLC 41, Section 29, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M., SE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within N. Day DLC 40, Section 31, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion points located: Creek - 3290 feet North and 1420 feet East; River - 700 feet North and 3620 feet West; both *

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water from Calapooya Creek is limited to the period when the flow of the Umpqua River at tidewater is more than 525 cubic feet per second and the flow of the Calapooya Creek is more than 12 cubic feet per second at its mouth and provided further that the right to use of water from the Umpqua River is limited ** and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
