CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. Z. WALKER

of 1712 Limpy Creek Road, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring and stream and Limpy Creek

a tributary of Limpy Creek and Applegate River for the purpose of domestic use for four families

under Permit No. 28869 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 3, 1963 for 0.02 cubic foot per second and August 1, 1963 for 0.01 cubic foot per second from Limpy Creek

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed spring for domestic use of one family, 0.01 c.f.s. from Limpy Creek for domestic use of one family, and 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed stream for domestic use of two families and * or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 17, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, T. 36 S., R. 7 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

*supplemental domestic use in the residence served from Limpy Creek during the periods Limpy Creek water is not suitable for domestic use.

**Diversion points located: Spring - 870 feet North and 30 feet West from SW Corner, Section 16; Stream - 30 feet South and 980 feet West, Limpy Creek - 520 feet South and 430 feet West, both from S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 16.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
