## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That DWIGHT PERKINS

of R. Box 117, Haines , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Powder River

a tributary of Snake River irrigation of 157.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 31143 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 17, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.93 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEW SEW, SWW. SEW, Section 18, T. 7 S., R. 38 E., W. M. Diversion points located: 700 feet North and 1620 feet West; 1660 feet North and 730 feet West; both from SE Corner, Section 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
