## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That LAWRENCE F. CARDA

of Route 1, Box 257, Monroe , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the water; of Oliver Creek

o tributary of Muddy Creek (Mary's River) irrigation of 28.8 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 31780 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 19, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.36 oubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEW SWW as projected within Buckingham DLC 53, Section 13, T. 14 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 3880 feet South and 2520 feet West from NE Corner, Buckingham DLC 53.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightlieth of one cubic foot per second per ucre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

20.0 acres NE34 SW/4
8.8 acres NW/4, SW/4
Both as projected within Buckingham DLC 53
Section 13
T. 14 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
