CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE W. NEUNER, TRUSTEE FOR
 CAROL A. and ROBERT J. WHIPPLE
 of 810 S.E. Douglas Ave., Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof
 to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
 Umpqua River
 a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of
 irrigation of 147.7 acres
 under Permit No. 31472 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
 confirmed dates from March 30, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
 1.85 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
 The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Gant DLC 50, Section
 7, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Gant DLC 50, Section 8, T. 23 S., R. 7 W., W. M.
 Diversion points located: 2110 feet East and 1170 feet North; 3580 feet East
 and 2360 feet North; both from SW Corner, Gant DLC 50.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
 right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
 per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
 to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
 during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall
 conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
 appurtenant, is as follows:

0.3 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
 0.6 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
 33.1 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
