CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOSEPHINE COUNTY - A BODY POLITIC
by Board of County Commissioners
of Josephine County Courthouse, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of
Wolf Creek, tributary of Rogue River, in two Wolf Creek Recreation Ponds

for the purposes of
recreation

under Reservoir Permit No. R-4509 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said
waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right
hereby confirmed dates from January 11, 1965

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-
said, shall not exceed 1.2 acre feet, being 1.0 acre foot in Reservoir No. 1 and
0.2 acre foot in Reservoir No. 2.

The reservoir is located in

NW¼ NW¼
Section 22
T. 33 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This right is subject to the provision that an 8 inch outlet suitable to
pass the normal flow of the stream be constructed through the base of the
dam.
