**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** TOM E. HARDWICK

of 978 Sunny Valley Loop Road, Sunny Valley, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream and three reservoirs constructed under application number R-39060, permit number R-3866 a tributary of Grave Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 1.6 acres and supplemental irrigation of 5.6 acres

under Permit No. 29166 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 5, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Twogood DLC 37, Section 2, T. 34 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $4\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoirs constructed under permit number R-3866; provided further that the right to use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 cubic feet per second at its mouth,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Diversion points located: Reservoir No. 1 - 460 feet East and 1010 feet South; Reservoir No. 2 - 450 feet East and 1320 feet South; Reservoir No. 3 - 190 feet East and 1890 feet South; all from Center, Section 2.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
