CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PERCY and MARCELLA H. MURRAY
WILLIAM V. and DORIS MEADE
of 812 Pacific Terrace, Klamath Falls, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Five Mile Creek
a tributary of North Fork Sprague River for the purpose of
irrigation of 72.6 acres
under Permit No. 28441 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from October 4, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
1.82 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, T. 35 S.,
R. 13 E., W. M. Diversion points located: 3640 feet East and 30 feet North;
3180 feet East and 480 feet South; both from SW Corner, Section 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season of each year, and this permit is junior to the
rights of prior appropriators, as recognized in the Klamath River Basin Compact,
including rights of the United States for the Klamath Project; therefore diver-
sions authorized under this permit are limited to surplus flow of Five Mile
Creek not required for use within the Klamath Project and the proposed diversion *
and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

* works will be so constructed that the unregulated runoff can be passed through
the works without impeding the flow downstream from the works or impairing
downstream rights,
