CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FITZGERALD BROS., A PARTNERSHIP

of Plush , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Honey Creek (Hart Lake) supplemental irrigation of 216.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-1955 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 2, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.71 cubic feet per second, being 0.57 cubic foot per second from Well No. 1 and 2.14 cubic feet per second from Well No. 2,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEW SEW, Section 17, T. 36 S., R. 24 E., W. M. Wells located: No. 1 - 2140 feet North and 230 feet West; No. 2 - 2140 feet North and 220 feet West; both from SE Corner, Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
