**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** OREGON STATE GAME COMMISSION

of 1634 E. W. Alder Street, Portland            State of Oregon            , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Foster Spring and reservoirs No. 1 and 2 constructed under application number R-38010, permit number R-3204 a tributary of Summer Lake            for the purpose of Wild Fowl propagation

under Permit No. 28554            of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 29, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 3, T. 31 S., R. 16 E., W. M. Diversion points located: Spring - 380 feet South and 220 feet East from N $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 3; Reservoir No. 1 - 900 feet South and 860 feet East; \*

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 3  
T. 31 S., R. 16 E., W. M.

\* Reservoir No. 2 - 870 feet South and 1280 feet East; Rediversion - 540 feet South and 130 feet East; all from N $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 3.

This right is subject to the provision that no water may be appropriated during the irrigation season.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
