## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That

Route 2, Box 336, Mapleton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and Hadsall Creek

a tributary of Siuslaw River irrigation of 10.5 acres and domestic use of one family for the purpose of

under Permit No. 28523 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 17, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from the unnamed stream for domestic and 0.13 cubic foot per second from Hadsall Creek for irrigation,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEM, NWM, NWM, SEM, NWM, Section 13, T. 18 S., R. 10 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 0.1 acre SW4 NEX O.1 acre NED NWM Domestic and 2.8 acres NWA NWA 0.2 acre SW/4 NW/4 7.3 acres SEM NWA Section 13 T. 18 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

Diversion points located: Unnamed stream - 100 feet South and 1500 feet East; Hadsall Creek - 600 feet South and 400 feet East; 1490 feet South and 1310 feet East; 1740 feet South and 2060 feet East; all from the NW Corner, Section 13.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
