CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That KEITH CROCKER

of Route 3, Junction City, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Well No. 2 and Well No. 3

a tributary of Long Tom River (Willamette River) for the purpose of irrigation of 73.7 acres and supplemental irrigation of 65.7 acres under Permit No. G-2591 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 15, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.83 cubic foot per second, being 0.75 cubic foot per second from Well No. 2 and 0.08 cubic foot per second from Well No. 3,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Richardson DLC 44, Section 10, NE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Richardson DLC 44, Section 15, T. 14 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Wells located: Well No. 2 - 1130 feet North and 1100 feet West; Well No. 3 - 2420 feet North and 2260 feet West; both from SE Corner, Richardson *

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
