that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second, being 0.3 cubic foot per second for log pond maintenance and 1.7 cubic feet per second for manufacturing,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE% NE% as projected within McCoy DLC 60, Section 16, T. 14 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 70 feet South and 180 feet West from NE Corner, Section 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,
