CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DARWIN WILCOXEN and ELIZABETH WILCOXEN

of Elsie Route, Box 72, Seaside, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cow Creek

a tributary of Nehalem River for the purpose of stock and domestic use of one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden under Permit No. 32838 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 15, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic and 0.005 cubic foot per second for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, T. 5 N., R. 7 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 750 feet South and 140 feet East from NW Corner, Section 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
