CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That **LUKE RYAN**

of **Medford**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the **STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon**, of a right to the use of the waters of **Big Butte Creek**

a tributary of _____ for the purpose of **Irrigation** under Permit No. **E. 168** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the **STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon**, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume **1**, at page **447**, on the **15th** day of **November, 1922**; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **April 15, 1913**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **1.13** cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: **8 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 11 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 24 1/2 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 12 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Three, Township Thirty-four South, Range One; 11 1/2 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 21 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 2 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-four, Township Thirty-three South, Range One: All East of Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon. Containing in all 90 acres of land.**

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
