**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** ROBERT and FAY B. BOLIN

of **Box 35, Beaver**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of **Nestucca River** for the purpose of domestic use of one family (Trailer House)

under Permit No. **32213** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **December 7, 1966**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.005 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 23, T. 3 S., R. 9 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 150 feet North and 90 feet East from SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 23.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
