CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That CHAS, MORRILL

of Freewater, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Goodman Spring Branch, a tributary of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of the irrigation of 73 acres of land and domestic use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 466;
~~that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from~~

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed to the extent of all water
in the stream remaining after the rights of Alice Lawson, Wm. Records, W.S. Edwards and E.C.
Kralman as defined in said decree are satisfied; and shall not exceed 1.50 cubic feet per
second; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appur-
tenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
35½ acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 37½ acres in the North-
west quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-nine, Township Six North,
Range Thirty-five East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
