## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROBERT J. VANDE BERGH

of Route 1, Box 24, Forest Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring, an unnamed stream, and reservoir constructed under application number R-41094, permit number R-4616

a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 8.6 acres and domestic use of one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre of lawn and garden,

under Permit No. 30647 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 15, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from spring for domestic use and 0.11 cubic foot per second from unnamed stream and reservoir for irrigation,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE¼ SE¼, Section 18, NE¼ NE¾, Section 19, T. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit number R-4616,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres SW/ SE%
Domestic and 3.6 acres SE% SE%
Section 18
T. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Diversion points located: Reservoir - 1280 feet North and 1180 feet West; Spring - 630 feet South and 910 feet West; both from SE Corner, Section 18.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
